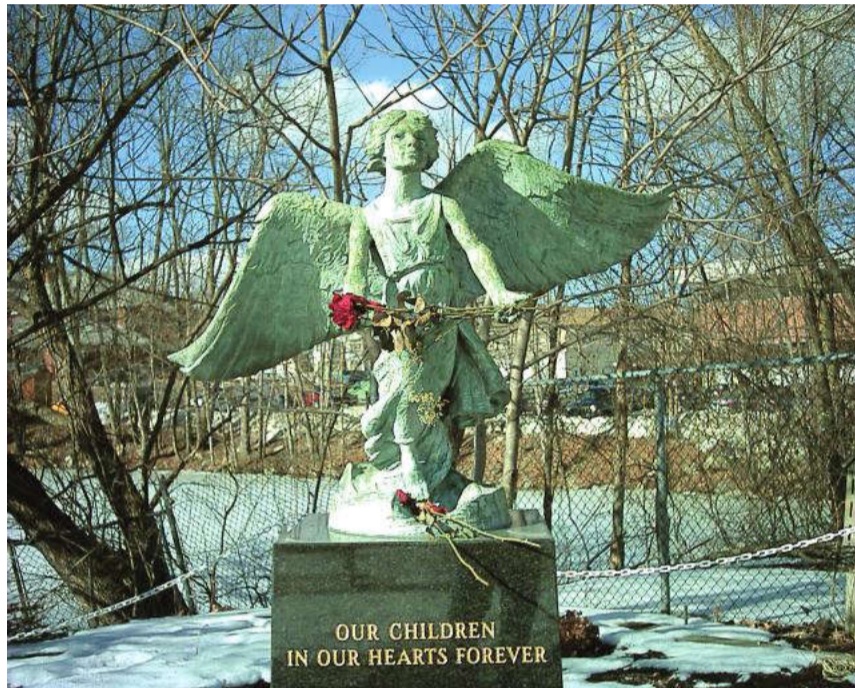


"ONE-CONDITIONAL" LOVE

In other words, He "turned the tables" on those who had no respect for the sanctity of God's place (& Goodness) in the world.



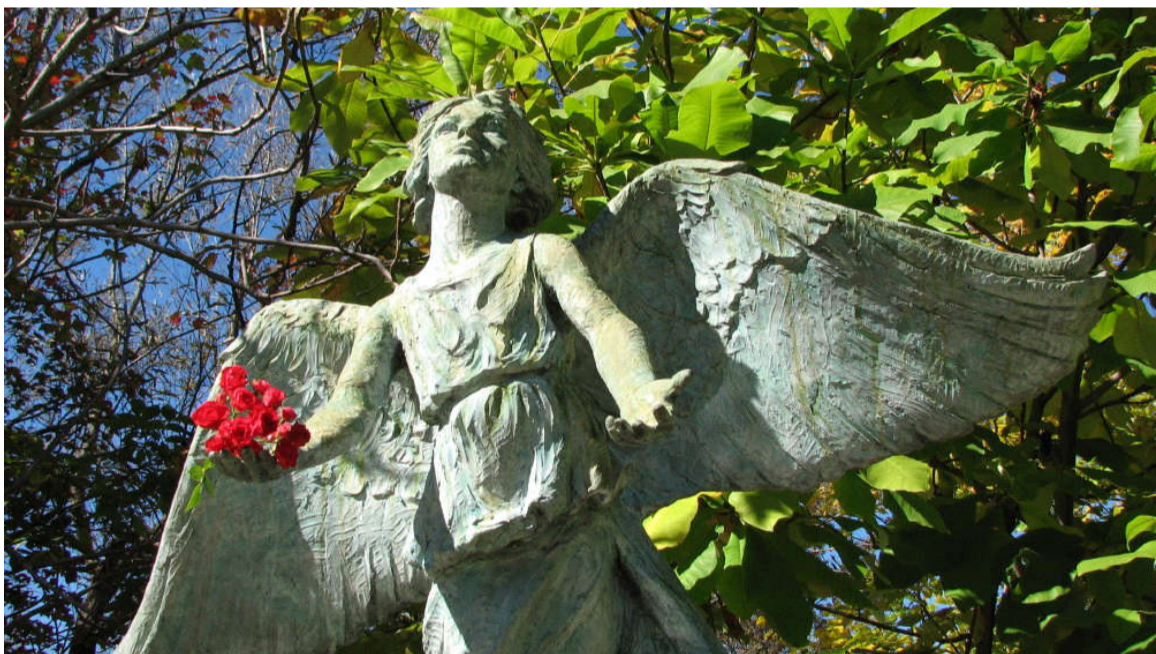

After all, even an otherwise loving, docile pet will learn to either avoid and/or attack its keeper if repeatedly, cruelly mistreated.

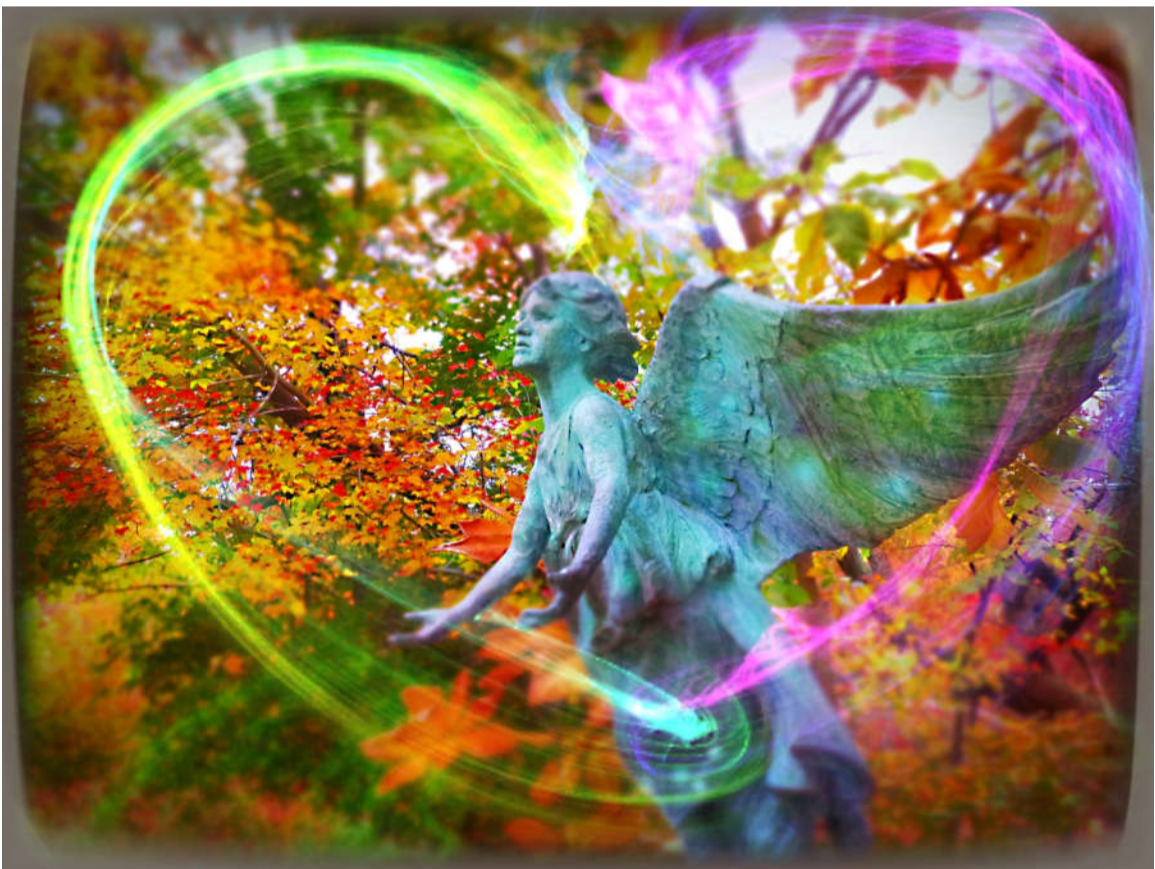

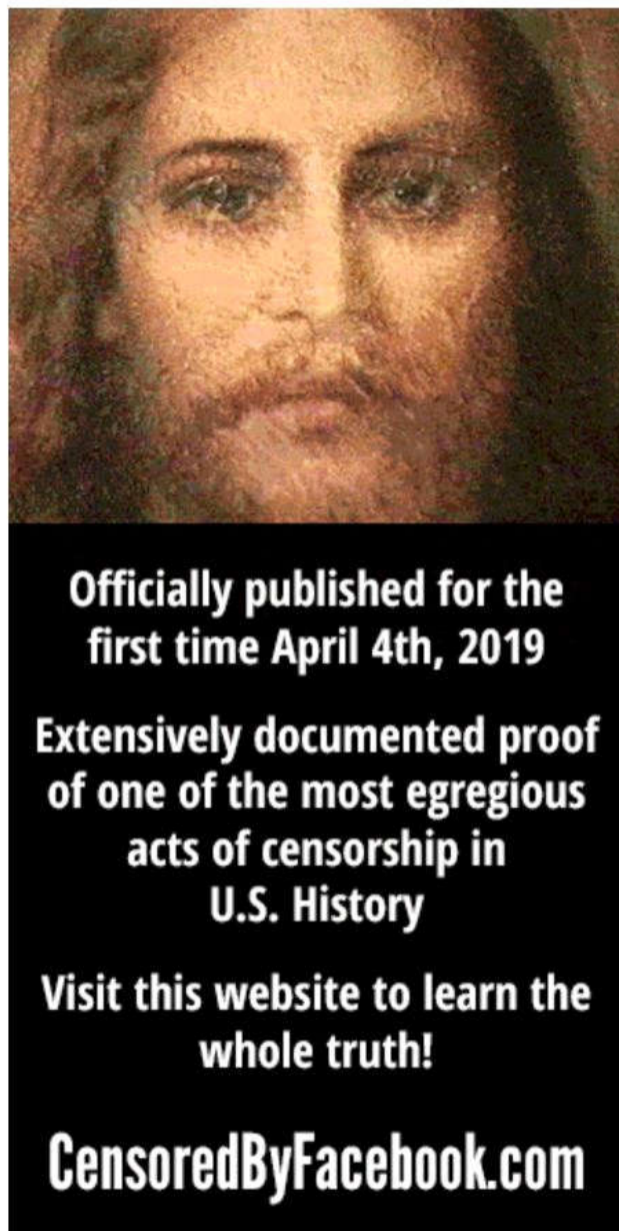
In other words: live, love, give & forgive - **mutually**.
